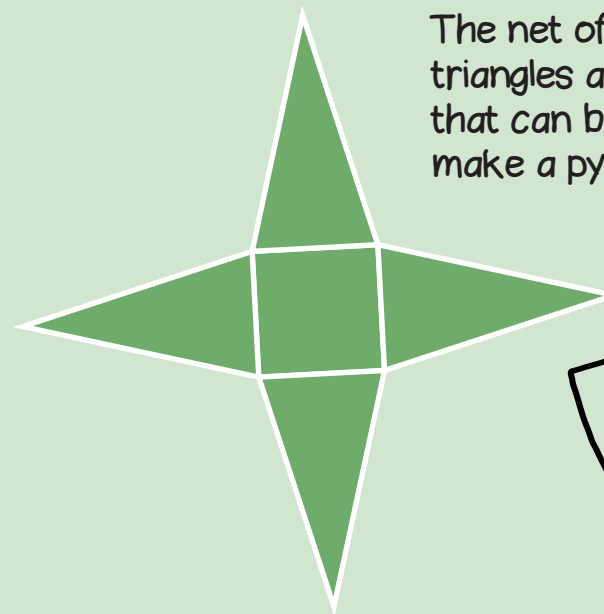
The net of a cube
