When subtracting fractions with the same denominators the denominator stays the same, just subtract the numerators.

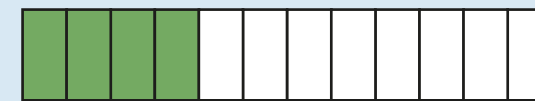
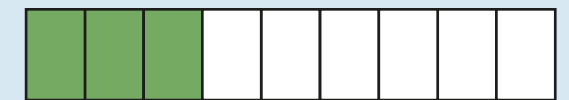
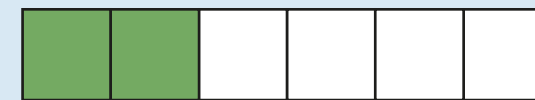
