

Dear Children, Parents and Carers,

Responding with Faith and Thanks

Give Thanks to the Lord - Luke 17:11-19



"Rise and go on your way; your faith has made you well." Luke 17:19

This week we have reflected upon responding to God with faith, and giving thanks for His mercy and His love for us. Last Sunday's Gospel reading demonstrates this clearly with the story of the cleansing of the ten lepers. The lepers, outcasts in their community, cried out to Jesus and had faith that He would respond. They were not disappointed. All ten were healed by Jesus. God loves us so much that He wants to give us all that we need. He encourages us to ask for what we need and put our faith and trust in Him.

Only one of the ten, the Samaritan, came back to thank Jesus. His response of thanks and praise to Jesus, shows his faith and his acknowledgement of Jesus as his Saviour.

We have looked at the many ways in which we give thanks. From an early age we are taught to say "thank-you" – to recognise that someone has gone out of their way to give us something or do something for us. Our thanks strengthens those relationships that bind us together, and it is the same with God. As we recognise the good things in our lives and in our world that come from God, so our faith is deepened and our bond with Him strengthened.

4J had a great time doing their experiment in Science. They collected three different types of soil from around school and tested it to see which was the most permeable ...


