Dear Children, Parents and Carers,

Temples of the Holy Spirit – We Are God's Temple John 2:13-22



'Do not make my Father's house, a house of trade.' John 2:16

In school we have reflected upon last Sunday's Gospel Reading. In this reading we recall one of the few examples of Jesus being angry and 'driving out' those who had turned the Temple into a market place to sell animals and exchange money. Jesus' anger was not only about how people were treating God's house, but about their attitudes towards God.

In this Gospel Reading Jesus refers to His own body as a Temple. When His actions are questioned by those in authority Jesus responds 'Destroy this Temple and in three days I will raise it up.'

Through the Gospel, Jesus wants us to understand that God is not only present in churches and holy buildings but He is present and lives in us.

Because of Jesus' death and resurrection, we are called to be 'Temples of the Holy Spirit'. God the Holy Spirit finds a home in each of us. Jesus reminds us that with God the Holy Spirit living within us, we can live out our faith every day by sharing God's love and presence with those around us.
