## September 2027 Admissions Policy Consultation – Emmaus Catholic Academy Trust

I am writing to you as a parent/carer of a child at a school within Emmaus Catholic Academy Trust. We are currently within a consultation process regarding our school admissions arrangements, and the draft policy is enclosed for your reference.

Please be assured that this makes no difference to the continued education of your child and that there are no major changes proposed to our existing approaches. We are required by the Department for Education to consult on these arrangements at least every seven years and parents/carers form an essential part of this.

The only change that you may find in comparison to pre-existing admissions policies is the equal first-priority that our proposed policy places upon both baptised Catholic and non-baptised children in care, which we believe aligns best with our commitment to serving society. Otherwise, I believe that much of the remaining policy remains unchanged from existing versions.
