## Gospel Reflection



### Fisher of Men

Matthew 4:12-23 From that time Jesus began to preach, saying,

“Repent for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”

In Sunday's Gospel Matthew tells us the story of Jesus beginning His ministry. The word 'repent' can seem harsh and strict, but we have reflected that what it really means is to 'turn around, change direction, come home to God'. Jesus does not begin His ministry and works with condemnation – He begins with an invitation. In Matthew's Gospel Jesus calls His first disciples. They are fishermen – ordinary, hard-working people. Jesus does not choose based on skill, qualification or merit. He simply says to them, "Follow me." And they do. Not because they understand everything, but because something in His voice tells them this is the way.

Jesus is still calling us today – like with the first disciples, not just the wise or holy, but all of us. Matthew reminds us that Jesus brings light to those who sit in darkness. We can all know darkness in our lives and times of trouble, anxiety, grief and loneliness. Jesus enters into the darkness and brings hope. He comes to shine a light, not just for the world, but for each of us personally. His voice is near, we need to listen to Him and be attentive.


Reception have been using different objects to subitise and make different number bonds up to 10 ...
