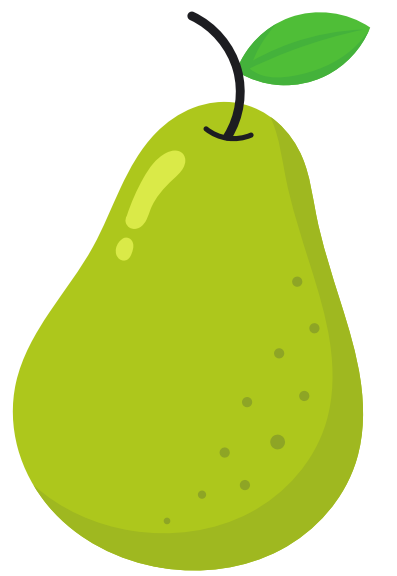




Pear Tree Primary School

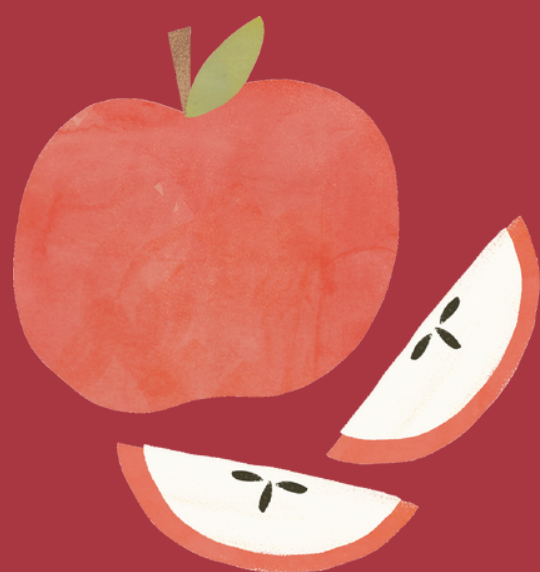

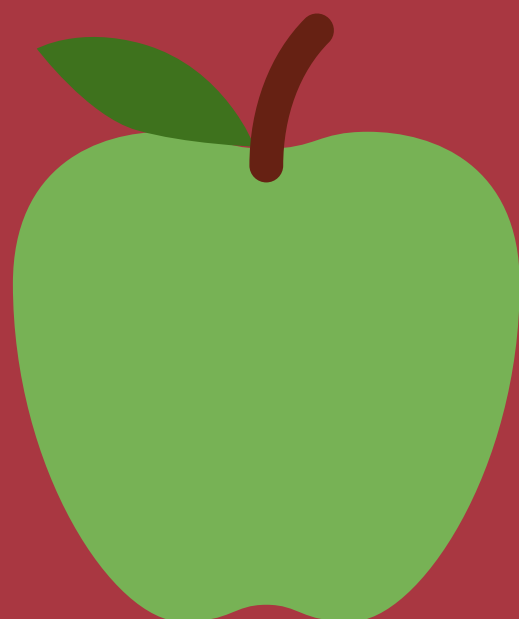

RED CLASS

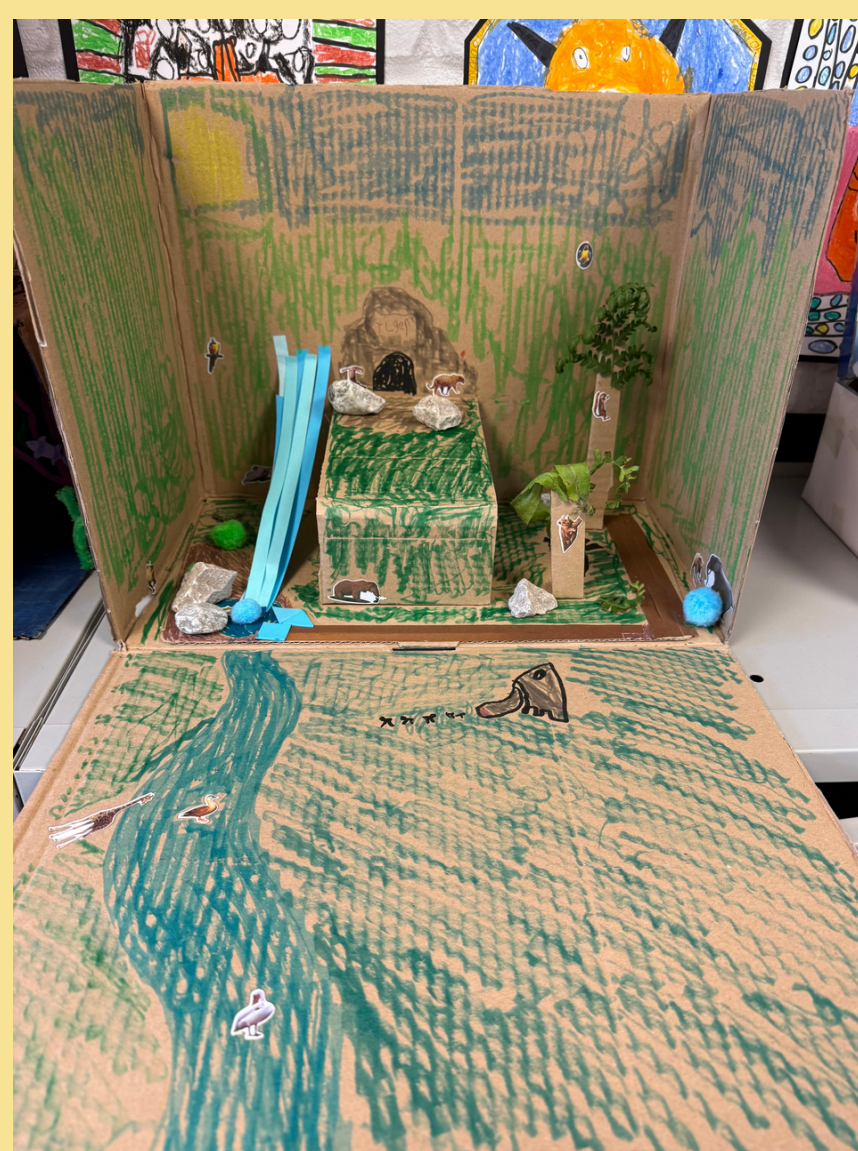

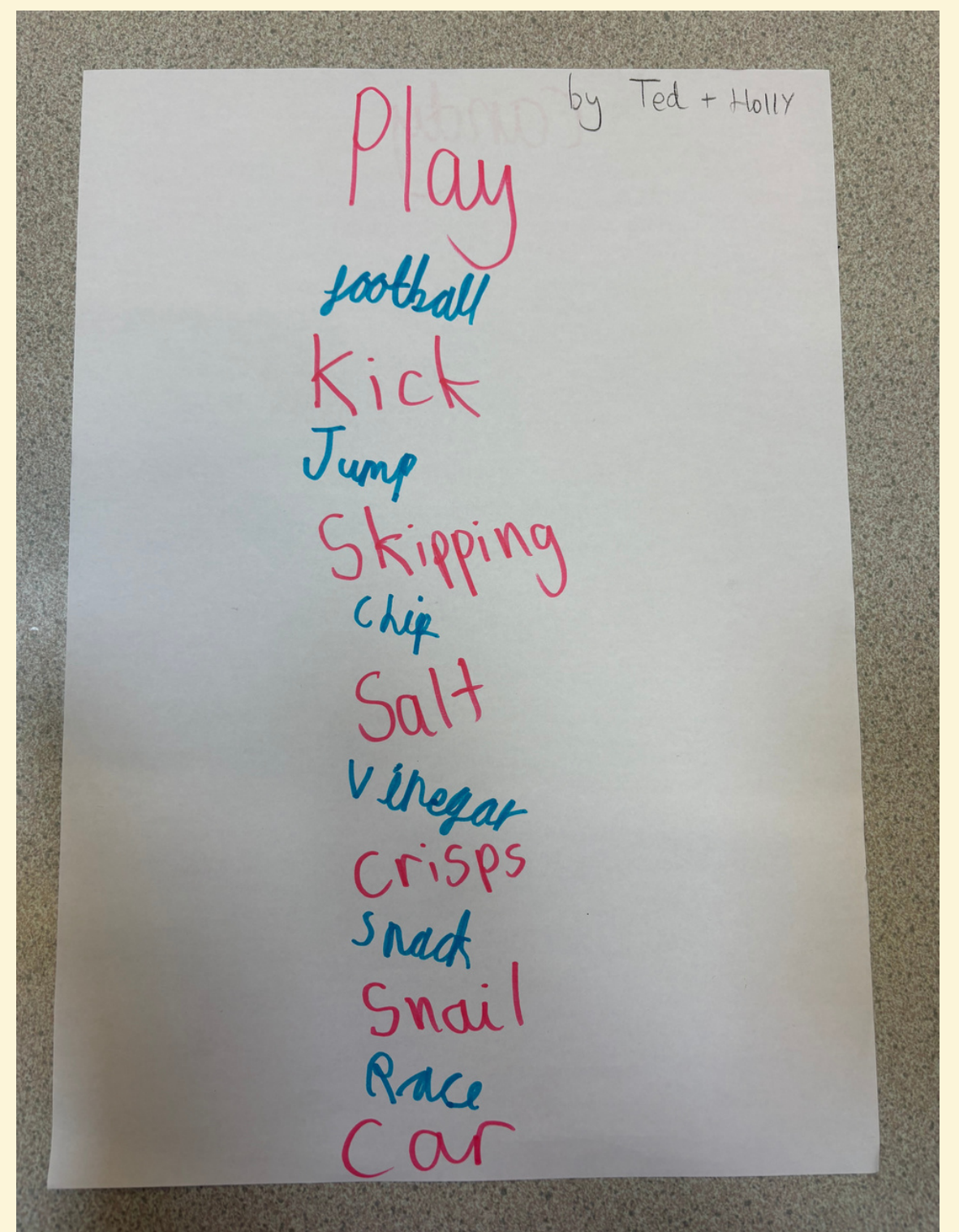
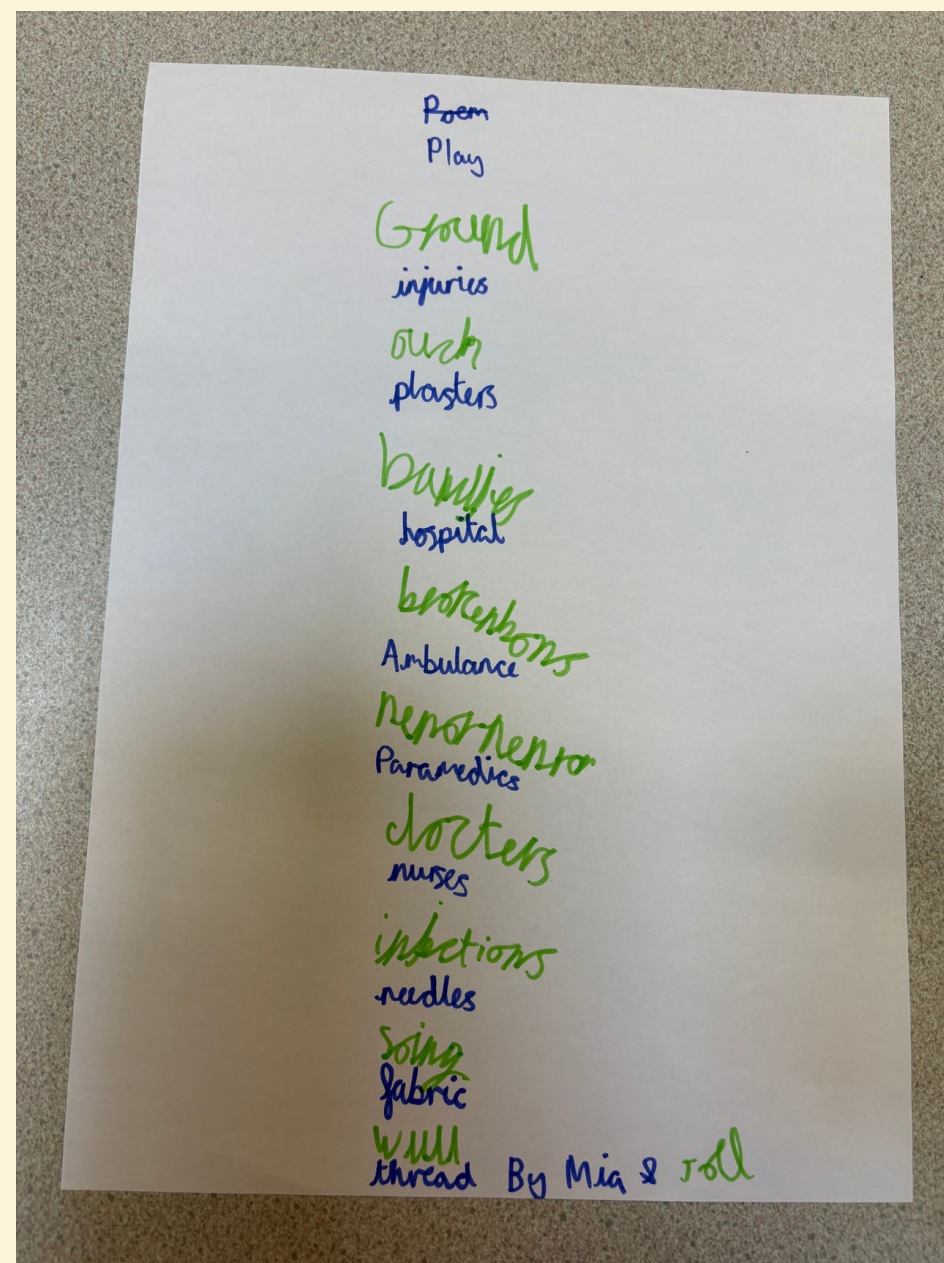
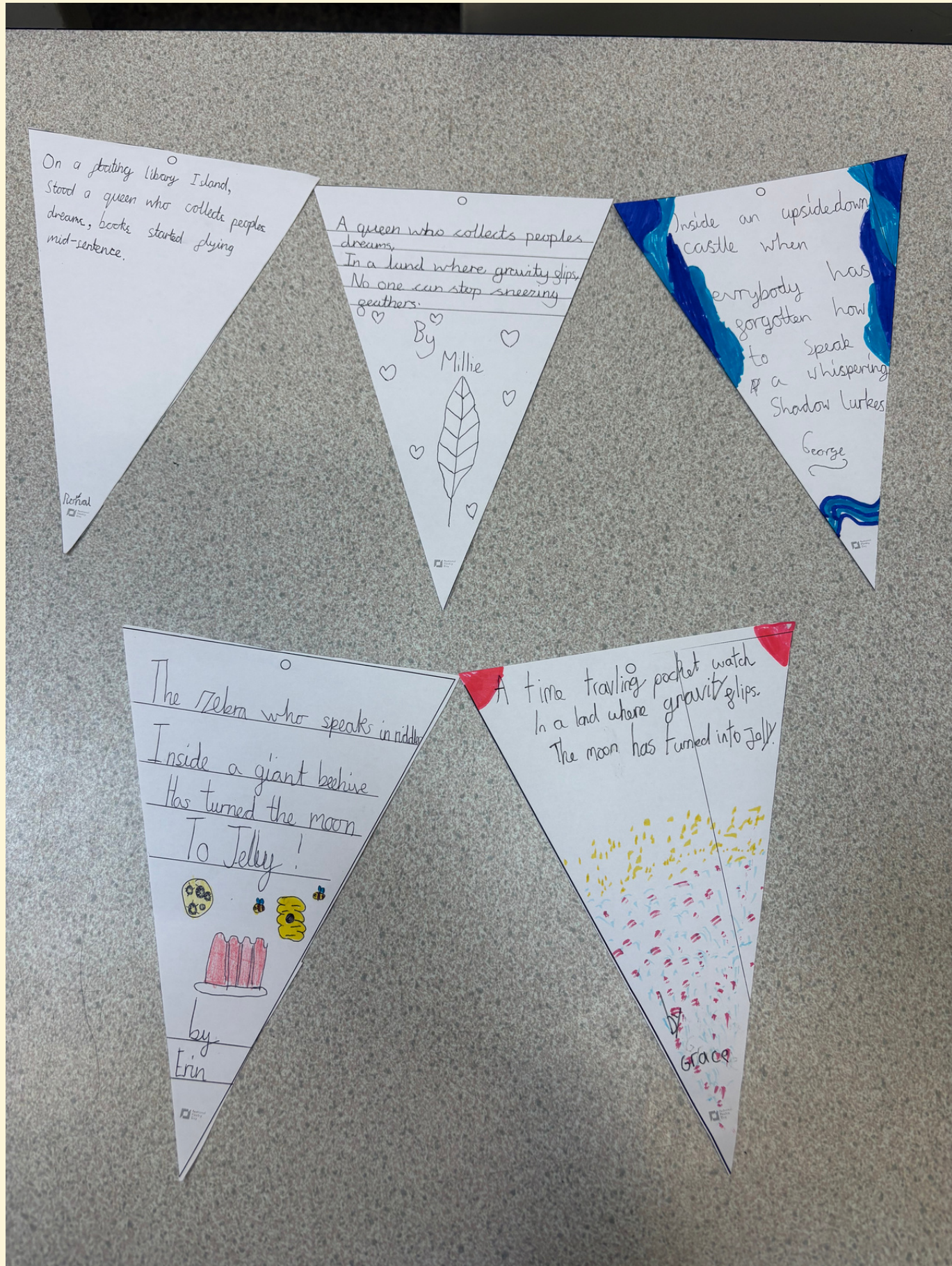
KS1 FOOTBALL

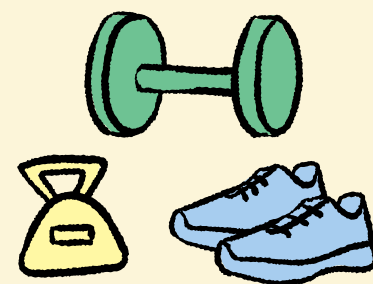


Our wonderful PTA have organised a 'neon' school disco for Friday 10th October. Red, Orange & Yellow classes 6.00-6.45pm.

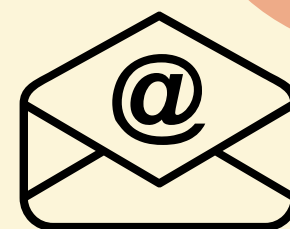
