


Pear Tree Primary School

Prefects


Introducing our full prefect team...



We found that the brine that comes from springs right in the middle of Nantwich is at least five times more salty than sea water.


Thank you to everyone who supported and donated to our Hello Yellow fundraiser. We raised £117 for Young Minds, well done!




PE Uniform


