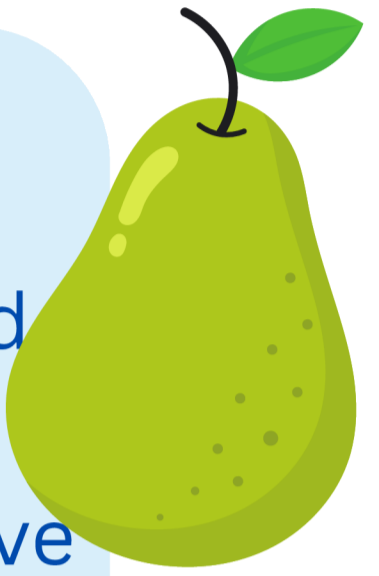

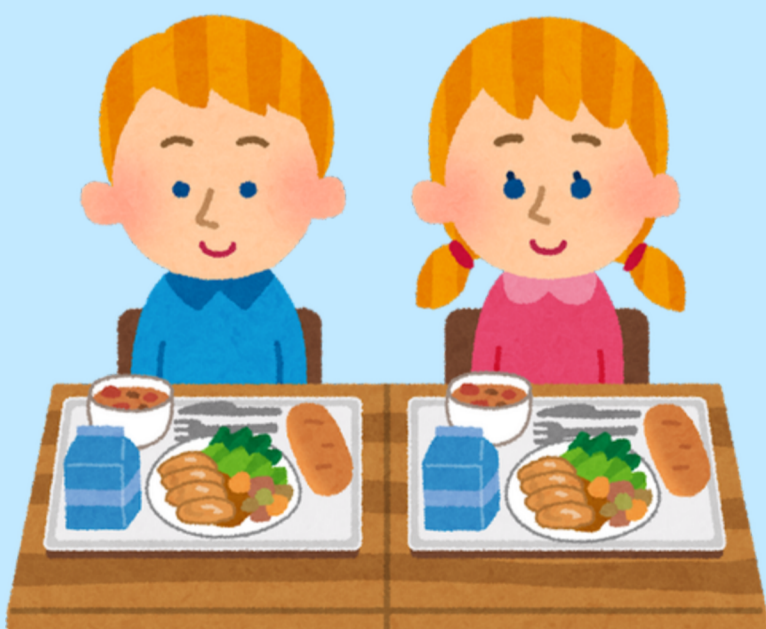

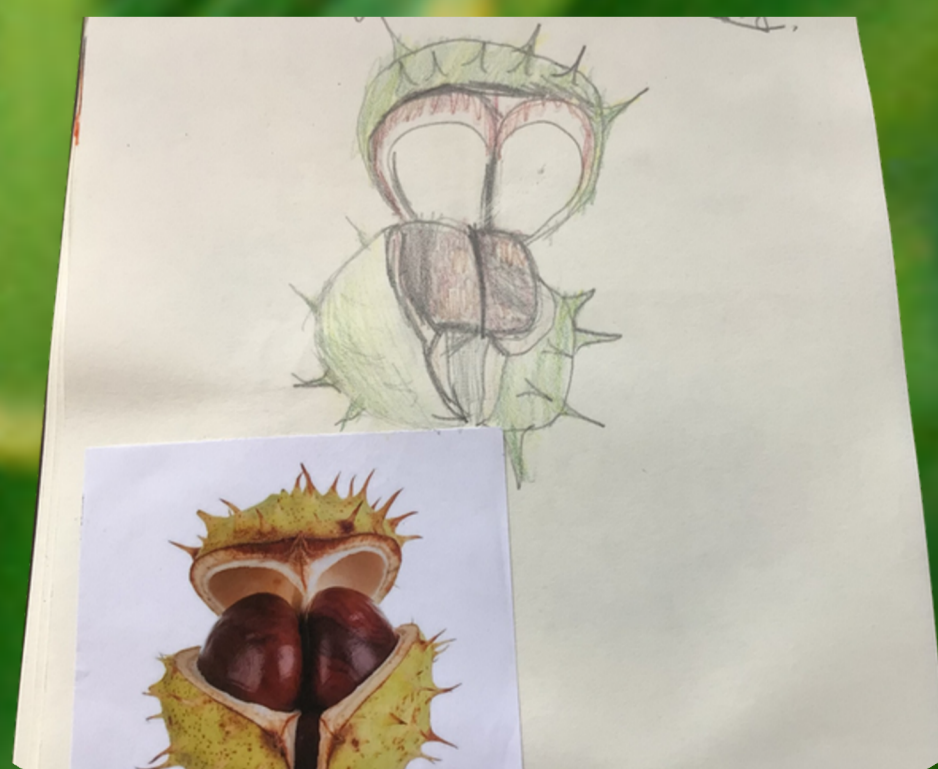
We are currently recruiting for a Midday Assistant to work from 11.45am to 1.15pm. We would consider a job share if you are not available every day.

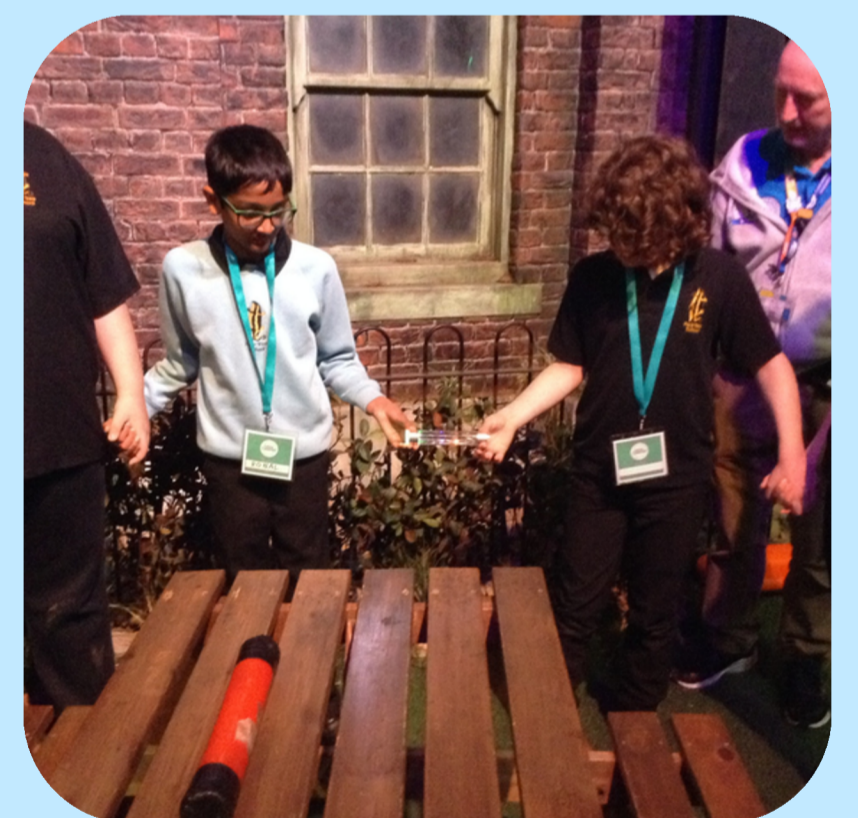

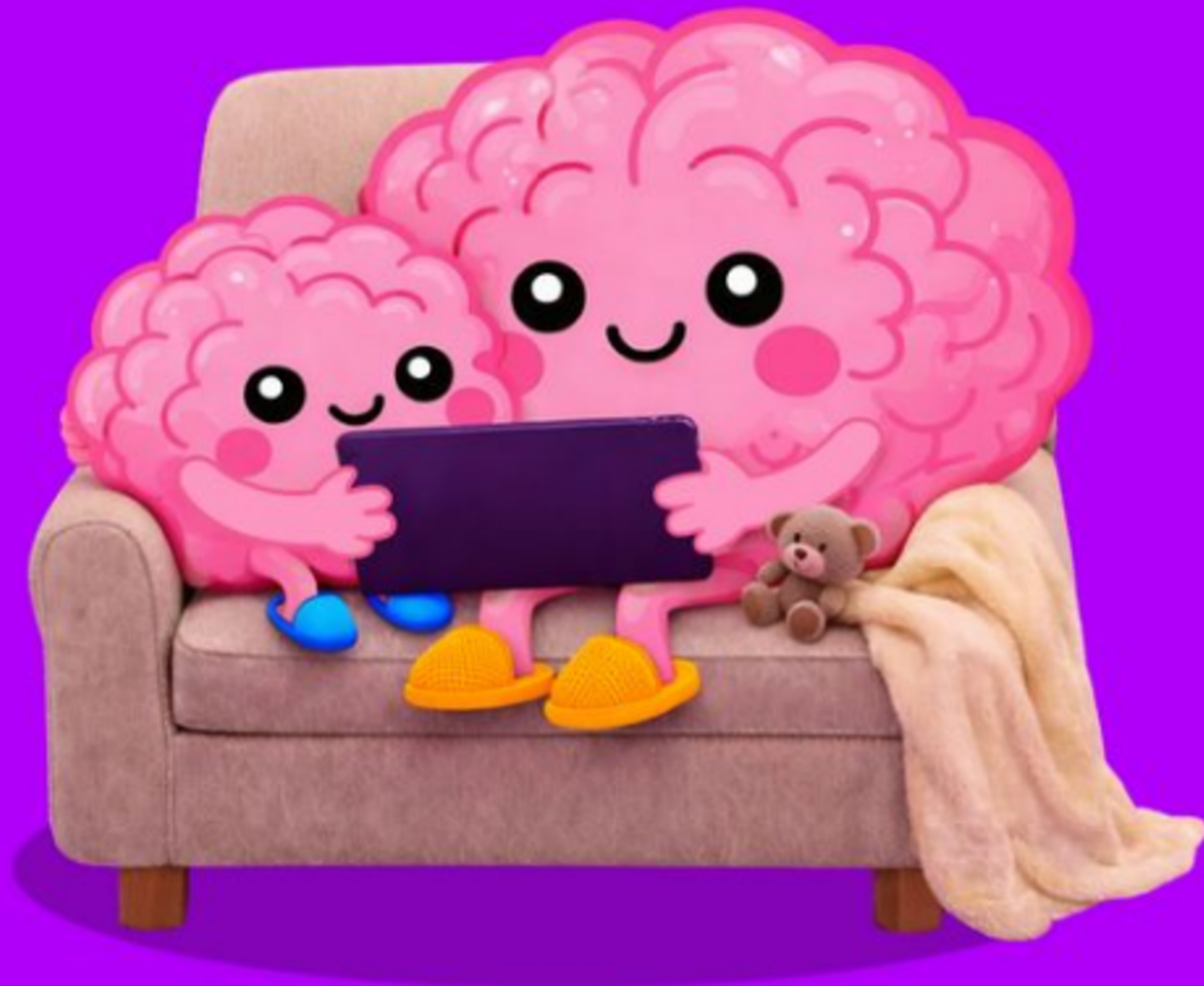
Indigo Class
