

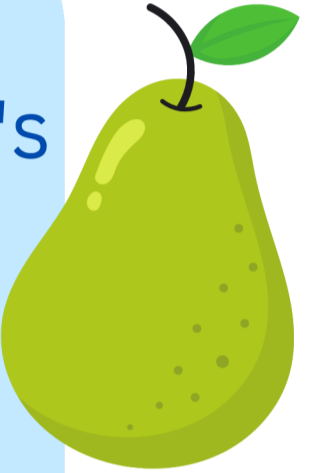

It has been another busy week in school, especially for the Year 6's who have completed their SAT tests.

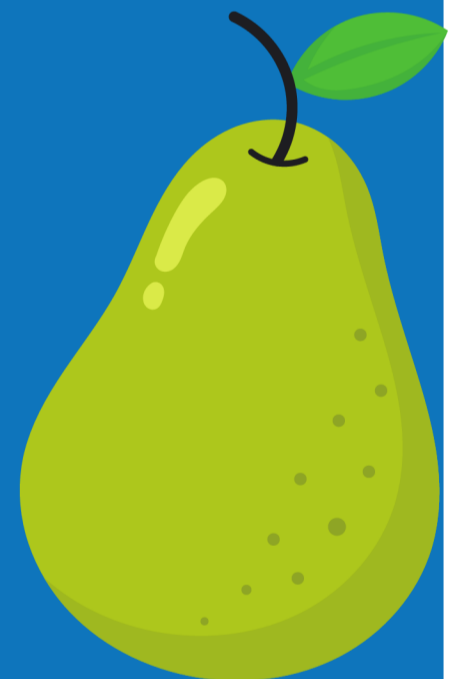
Our Year 6's are now preparing for their end of year show and looking forward to their trip to London in a few weeks.
