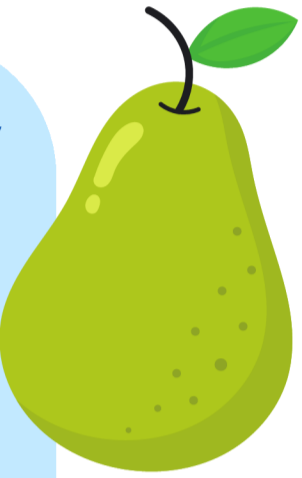




Pear Tree Primary School
