

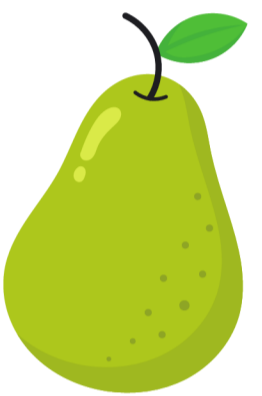


Pear Tree Primary School

Blue class completed level 1 Bikeability on Monday.

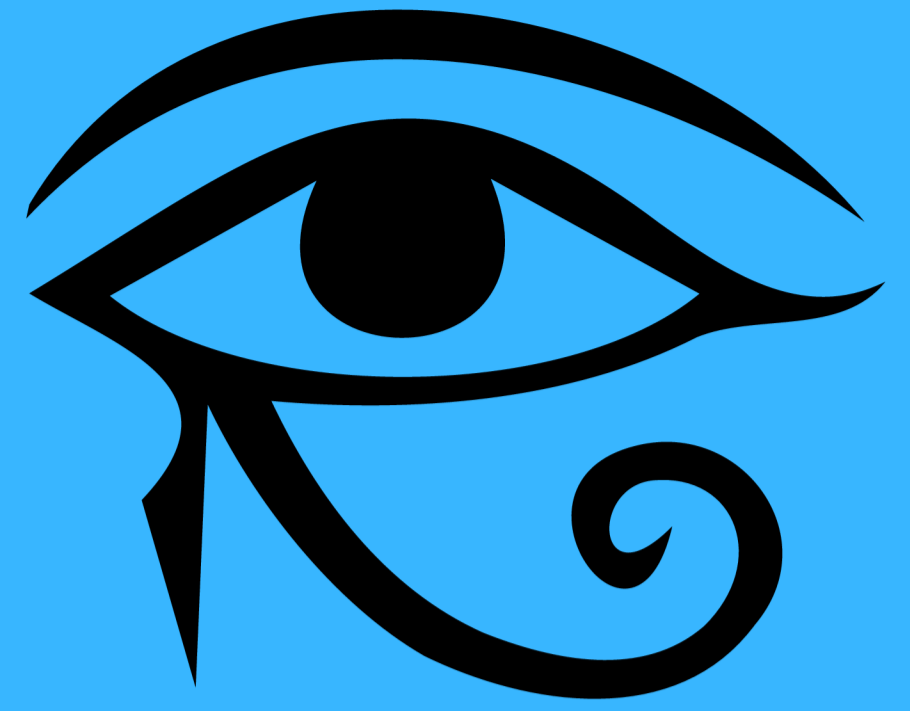
Everyone passed with flying colours.
