Rural	The countryside.
Union Flag	The Union Flag, or Union Jack, is the national flag of the United Kingdom.
England - London	Country of the UK and its capital city.
Northern Ireland - Belfast	Country of the UK and its capital city.
Scotland - Edinburgh	Country of the UK and its capital city.
Wales - Cardiff	Country of the UK and its capital city.
The British Isles	The British Isles are made up of: Ireland, Northern Ireland, Scotland, England and Wales.
The United Kingdom or UK	The United Kingdom (owned by the British crown) includes: Northern Ireland, Scotland, England and Wales.
Great Britain	Great Britain is simply the land mass that incorporates Scotland, England and Wales.
