KEY VOCABULARY

Pentecost	Pentecost is celebrated 50 days after Easter and is when Christians remember the gift of the Holy Spirit .
The Trinity	The three separate forms God is known by. Father, son and Holy spirit.
Parable	A parable is a short and simple story that has a moral or spiritual lesson that can be learnt from it.
Brahma	Brahma is one of the three major gods of Hindus. Brahma is said to be the creator of the whole universe.
Vishnu	Vishnu is the preserver god, which means he protects the earth from being destroyed and keeps it going
Shiva	Shiva is one of the three main gods in Hinduism. Shiva is known as the destroyer god because he removes all evil from the world
Hindu	Hindus believe in a universal soul or God called Brahman.
Trimurti	The word 'trimurti' means 'three forms'. In the trimurti, Brahma is the creator, Vishnu is the preserver and Shiva is the destroyer.
