Clubs

Reception applications:

The portal is now open for applications for Reception places for September 2026. Please apply at https://admission.tameside.gov.uk/CitizenPortal_LIVE/en The deadline for applications is 15th January 2026.

My Child's Art:

Children have created a Christmas artwork and these can be ordered as Christmas cards and lots of other items! Please go to this URL or type in mychildsart.co.uk/find-artwork and use the username Livingstone and the password kn4w9bmq. Search for your child by name and order any artwork you would like. The school receives a percentage of each sale to go towards school funds. Items can be ordered up until the 31st of December.

Eco Committee News:

We have a new Eco Committee in school!

They are collecting used stamps to raise money for the British Hedgehog Preservation Society. If people could please send them in with roughly a 5mm border of envelope around each stamp, that would be wonderful. There will be collection boxes at each of the school entrances.

Also, the Eco Committee have organised for Livingstone School to be a recycling point for used batteries. We accept AAA, AA, C and D type batteries. Again, there will be collection boxes at each of the school entrances.

Schools Grid School Meal ordering and Payment system:

We will be implementing a piece of new software called SchoolGrid for the ordering and payment of your child's school meals, starting from 19th January 2026. With SchoolGrid, you can order and pay for your child's meals with a few clicks. To get started, SchoolGrid will be sending you a welcome email with instructions on how to activate your account and create your password. Please note that in order for your account to be created, we will be sharing your information with SchoolGrid. You can view SchoolGrid's Privacy Policy on the following link:

You can order on a daily, weekly, monthly or even termly basis. The system will allow you to place as many orders in advance as you like, up to the point the menu has been opened for. You can also make a same-day order up to 8:55am. Please order with your child so that they can tell you which things they like to eat.

If you pay for your child's meals, then you have two options on SchoolGrid. You can top up your account by making a card payment or alternatively, you can set up a Direct Debit. To place an order, you need to ensure you have the relevant credit on your account or a Direct Debit set up. If you do not have these, you will be unable to order and will receive a reminder message to make payment.

With Direct Debit, SchoolGrid collects the payment on a monthly basis and it is collected in arrears. Your Direct Debit amount can vary depending on the amount of meals taken within the period so a statement will be sent to you two weeks prior to the collection, detailing the exact date and the amount to be collected, as well as all the meals included.

Please remember to cancel your order if your child will not be having the meal at lunchtime, otherwise you may still be charged. This also helps cut down on food wastage.

We hope that you find SchoolGrid easy to use and convenient for ordering and paying for your child's school meals. Should you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to get in touch.
