

Geography

In Geography, we will use maps, atlases, globes and computer mapping to locate the world's countries. We will focus on Europe and which countries were involved in World War Two.

Computing

In computing, we will study communicating systems and networks alongside cyberbullying as part of esafety.

Science

In science, we will be learning about how light travels ; how we see; and how shadows are formed.

Maths

In Maths, we will be focussing on place value including ordering and comparing. We will also work through all four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also develop greater fluency with arithmetic style questions.

PSHE

In PSHE, we are using the book 'The Thing' as part of No Outsiders. We will also look at assertiveness, cooperation, safe/unsafe touches and positive relationships.

English
