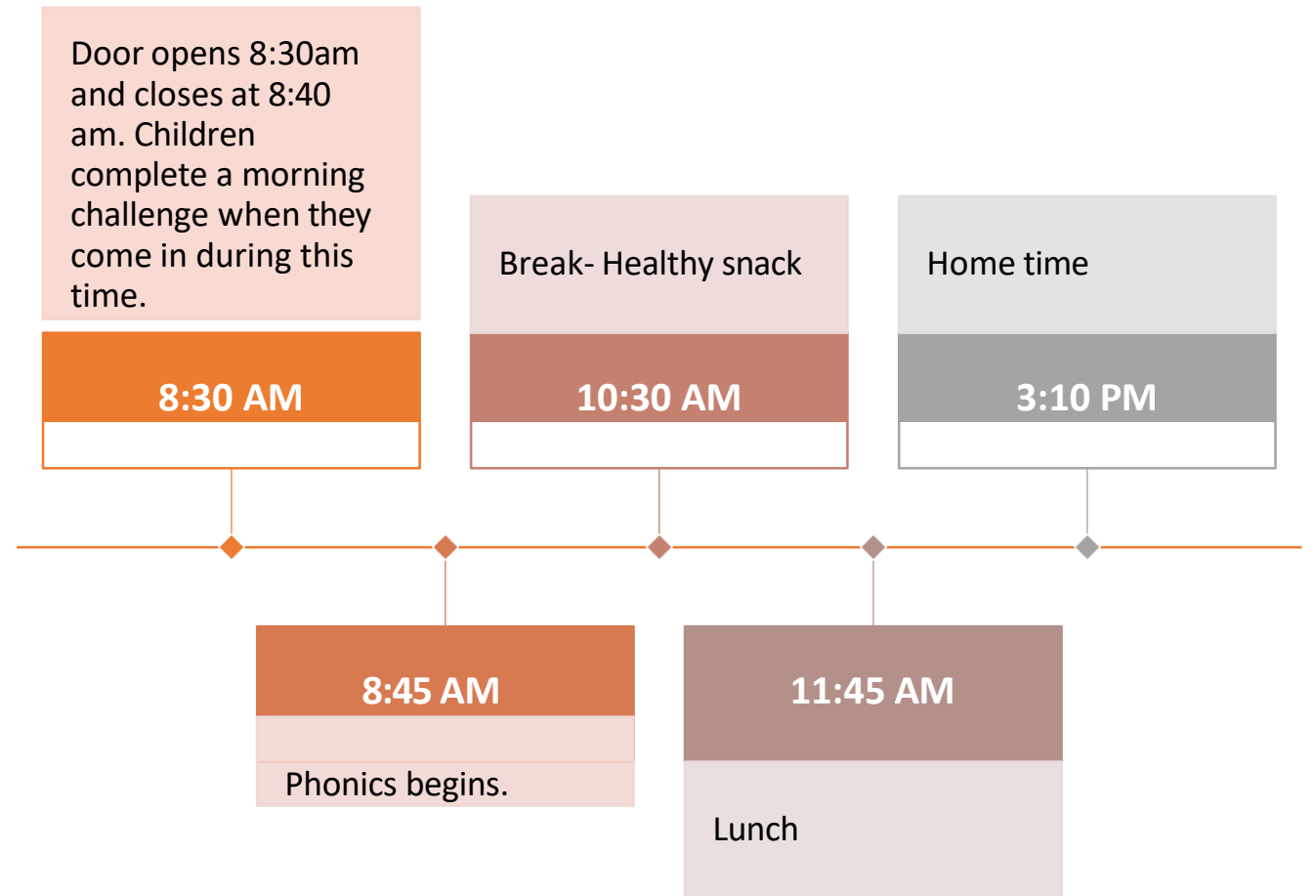

Year 1 expectation.

We follow the whole school rules of 'Be Ready, Be Respectful, Be Safe

Children are expected to read 3 times a week. Reading book will be changed on Tuesday.

Children will get weekly phonics handout to practice what has been taught in their lessons. Practice reading and writing the sounds and words.

Children must wear the correct uniform- grey skirt, trousers or shorts. White polo. Blue cardigan or jumper. Black shoes these can't be black trainers.

PE day children will come to school in PE kit.

Phonics



A huge focus of Year 1.



Phonics scheme is Little Wandle Letters and Sounds.



New reading books- ebooks which will have been shared with children in school during Reading Practice.



Minimum reading 3 times a week. (for everyday the children read the rocket moves on a Tuesday and earn different rewards.)



Phonics Screening assessment will take place in Summer 2. (week commencing 8th June)

This is the slip that will come home for phonics and spelling practice.

The children will have looked at these in phonics sessions during the week. There will be different variations depending on which phonics group they are in.

We ask you to practice reading and writing the sounds and words on the sheets.

Ask the children to read the sounds to you as quickly as they can, add sound button to the spelling words and circle the tricky part of the words.

In Autumn 1, we will be doing drawing club to encourage children to write. Then inline with rest of the school, Year 1 will follow Pathways to Write. Class will look at a new picture book each half term.

Year 1 begins by focusing on using the sounds children know to write words, finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

Maths

Year 1 and upwards follow Maths No Problem.

Lesson have a clear structure.

1. Paired discussion to being to solve a problem.
2. Guided practice as a class.
3. Independent work.

Additional practice at home can be done on Numbots.
It is games securing simple Maths understanding to being with and progressively gets hard as the children complete more of the challenge.
