

### In English...

We will be using a fiction book called 'Troll Swap' as the stimulus for our Writing. Our final piece will be a story focusing on the characters.

### In Maths...

We will be focusing on number and place value within numbers to 100. We will explore methods to add and subtract 2-digit numbers and count in our 2s. 5s and 10s to solve number facts.

#### In Science...

We will be exploring and comparing things that are living and non-living. Within our Forest School lessons. we will be looking at different habitats and discussing what makes a 'suitable' habitat.

### In PE...

We will be developing our defending skills through running, dodging and using the space.

We will be investigating and comparing the local area of Chester and a small village in Zambia. We will be focusing on the similarities and differences of the human and physical features of both places.


#### In PSHE...


The reading books sent home will be linked to the phonics phase your child in learning in class.

# Reading

We encourage reading as regularly as possible.

Please sign the reading log (even a tick or smiley face will do)

Reading three times a week gets your child's name in the sparkly box.

Each read will result in your child's rocket moving along the reading rocket route.

Children will be sent home/ assigned online the book they have read during reading practice sessions in school <u>and</u> another for additional practice.




Regular reading should take place. Class captain will be chosen every day.


### PSHE

### Hello and welcome to Ash Class!

My name is Miss Dalton and I am the class teacher in Year Two. Our fabulous teaching assistants are Mrs Hunt (Mon) and Miss Erskine (Tues-Fri)

In Year Two, we spend a lot of time working on our phonics, reading, writing and maths skills and enjoy using all the equipment around the classroom to help us learn. We will also begin to teach the children how to use our school's joined handwriting style. Throughout the year, we will also study lots of different topics such as The Gunpowder Plot, places around the world, nurses through history and much, much more!

For phonics, we use a phonics programme called Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised. For more information on how you can support at home, please go to

At the end of every day Miss Dalton, or another member of the team, will choose a Class Captain. This person gets to be at the front of the line and do all the important jobs for the day!

In line with the school procedures, reading books will be changed by an adult on **Mondays**. These books will link to their learning in phonics and develop their fluency. Each time your child reads and has their record signed, they will be able to move their reading rockets across the stars to reach the prizes and reading three times a week at home earns the children a ticket in the sparkly reading book! Please ensure reading books are sent into school everyday so we can read them with the children too.

PE will be on a Tuesday and Wednesday morning. Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit suitable for outdoors.
