- * classifying objects and identifying their properties

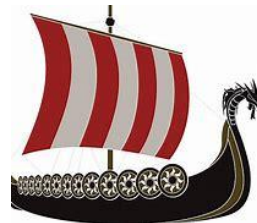
As historians we will continue to:

In RE, we will be:

- * exploring how Christians look after the wider world

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In Spanish, we will be:

- * Learning the Spanish vocabulary around animals.

In music, we will:

- * Work on music appreciation skills, to describe and evaluate different genres and types of music.

In Design Technology we will be designing and making our own kites

As mathematicians we will:

- * multiply and divide using formal written methods as appropriate, this will also involve reasoning and problem solving
- * work on rapid recall of times table facts up to 12×12
- * calculate area

As writers we will:

- * use the weather poems of Shirley Hughes as a stimulus to create our own poems
- * use the book 'Flotsam' to write well-structured descriptions about settings
- * understand and use commas after fronted adverbials; indicate possession by using the possessive apostrophe with singular and plural nouns; and punctuate direct speech
- * learn how to spell words on the Year 3 / 4 spelling list

In Computing we will be:

- using a variety of tools to create a program.
- recognising errors in programs and debugging.
- recognising that an algorithm will help to sequence more complex programs.
