RESIDENTIAL VISIT TO LONDON

Tuesday 24th to Wednesday 25th March 2026

After the amazing success of our London residential for the past two years, we are HUGELY excited to be able to share with you the initial arrangements for our Year 4 Residential to London, taking place in March 2026.

In addition to visiting our capital city, we will ensure that the 2 days are jam-packed with experiences and opportunities. Details and the agenda are still being finalised, but include:

Train to London, stop for a picnic lunch (brought from home) in a London park

A walk through London, seeing famous sites on the way

A visit to Parliament to learn about democracy and how our country is run

Seeing Big Ben, Westminster Bridge and The London Eye

360-degree views of the city from Horizon 22, which is currently the tallest building in London

Dinner at Pizza Express

Matilda in the West End.

We will be staying at Earls Court Youth Hostel for the night, where we will also enjoy a breakfast on the Wednesday morning.

The arrangements are still open to changes as numbers and bookings are finalised, but I am sure you will agree that we will fit an awful lot into a short period of time and provide your children with memories that they will cherish for life and may even inspire them for the future.

This is a complex residential to organise and we are subsidising it with school funds and a donation from FoWS to make this opportunity accessible for all. The total cost to parents will be **£140 per child**. This includes transport to and from London and when in London, dinner on day 1 and breakfast and lunch on day 2, overnight accommodation and trips to Parliament, the theatre and a skyscraper.

In order to book your child's place on this visit, please reply immediately to the survey with a 'YES' or 'NO' so that we can make further reservations and then make a **£20 non-refundable deposit via School Spider, by 15th October**.

As this residential is very different to our others, the way it is booked and paid for is also very different. This means that there is NO FLEXIBILITY and, unfortunately, the number of pupils who have paid the deposit by 15th October will be the final number able to attend, as all bookings are being finalised and deposits paid on 16th October.

The remaining £120 will then need to be paid via School Spider by **Wednesday 11th February 2026**.
