A Brighter Playtime: New Investment Brings Exciting Opportunities for Children

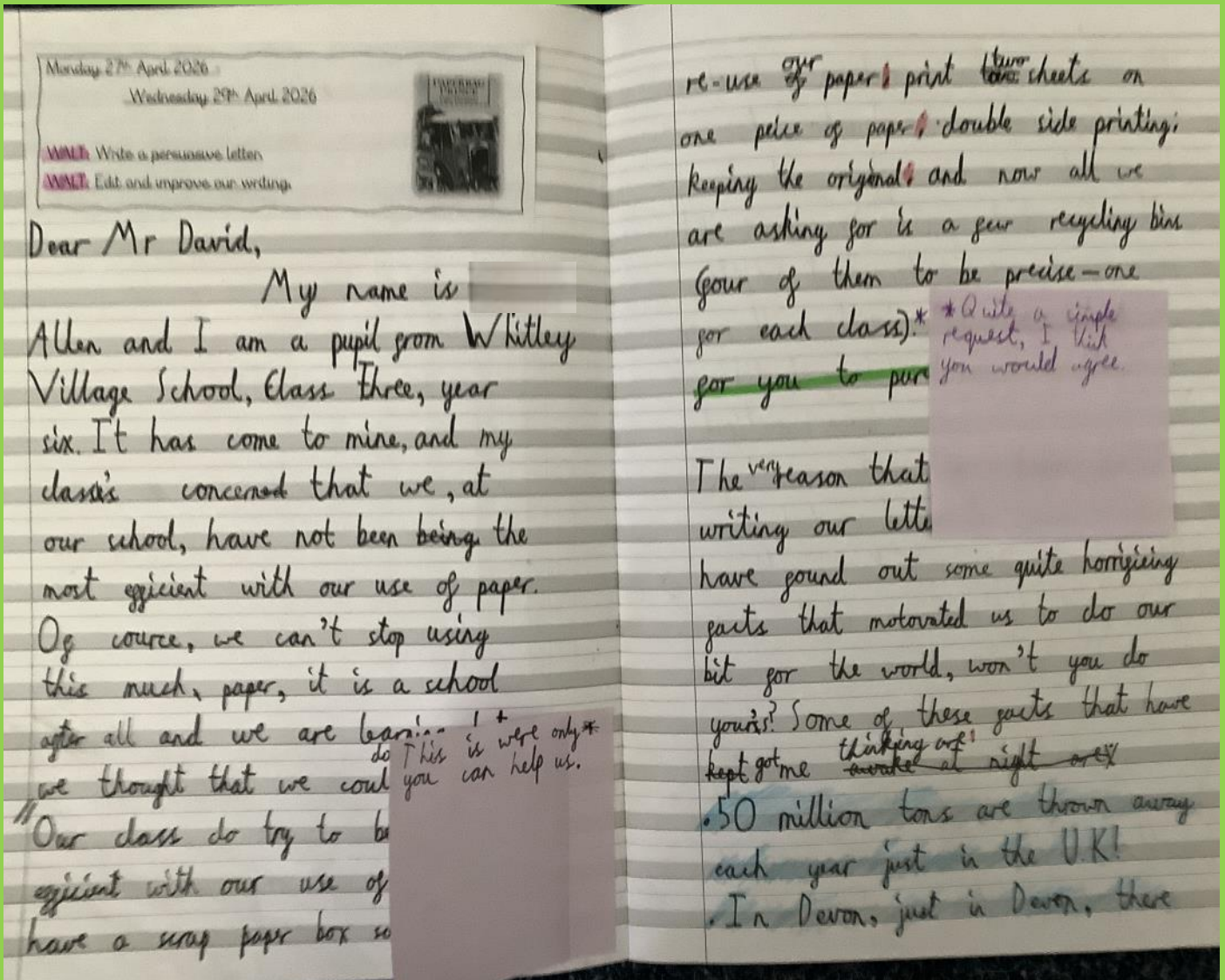

Children Changing the World: Powerful Letters Lead to Better Recycling

As part of our school vision, we aim to produce adults who go on to change the world. I am incredibly proud of the children in Miss Baines's class, because they have demonstrated that they have the skills to tackle important issues and carefully craft arguments. They did this by forensically laying out their views using facts and solutions, presented through carefully planned persuasive letters, complete with rhetorical questions designed to challenge the reader's current stance.
