



Governors' Information and Duties

Governors at Oughtrington are fully involved in all aspects of school life. They provide excellent support to the Head Teacher and school in general. In the academic year 2025 - 2026 there are currently 8 Local Governors comprising of; three Parent Governors, one Head Teacher Governor, one Staff Governor and three Co-Opted Governors. One Governor is the Chair, voted by all Governors. 1 of our Governors is of mixed background, 1 black Caribbean, 1 Pakistani and 5 are white British. In the academic year 2025-2026 current attendance at Full Governing Body Meetings is 97%.
