We are delighted to announce that we will be holding our first ever St Luke's Sponsored Colour Run on the school field. We are hoping to raise money for our school funds and we are sure this will be a memorable event.

The children will be taking part in a sponsored run/walk on the afternoon of Wednesday 15th July 2026. This event is designed to be a fun, physical activity that the children can enjoy taking part in with their friends and teachers. The children will be running a course of approximately 1km whilst coloured powder is thrown towards them through checkpoints.

The Sponsored Colour Run is one of our main fund-raising activities for the year, organised by the Friends of St Luke's, where all profits go towards helping the school run various events or activities for the children.

FAQs:

What happens in a Colour Run?

Children run around the field with their friends in age groups. Specially bought coloured powder is thrown towards them as they pass through checkpoints. The aim is to become as colourful as possible.

What do the children need to do in order to take part?

Ask family and friends to sponsor their run.

Each runner needs:

Old clothes that they are happy to become stained with colour, such as white t-shirts, tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts.

- Children come to school wearing these clothes and need:

- A towel

- A bottle of water

- A sun hat if required

Friends of St Luke's will provide sunglasses for every child for eye protection.

Children can also accessorise their clothing with a colourful items such as a tutu, wig, socks, etc.

Children will get colourfully messy and school is not responsible for any damage to clothing.

Net Profit

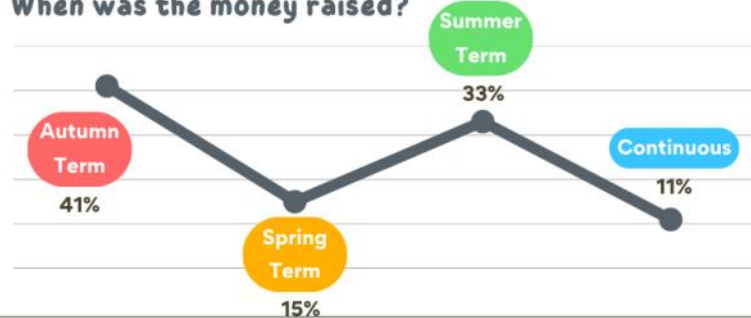
(Total profit minus expenses)
