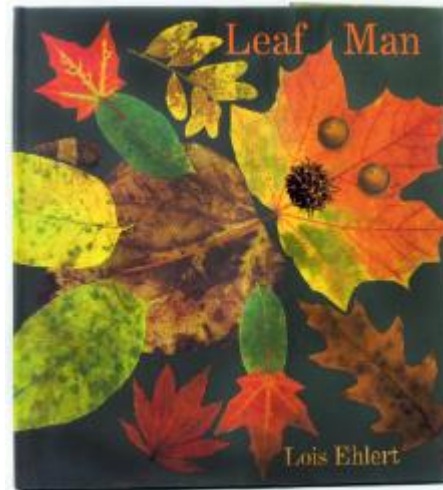
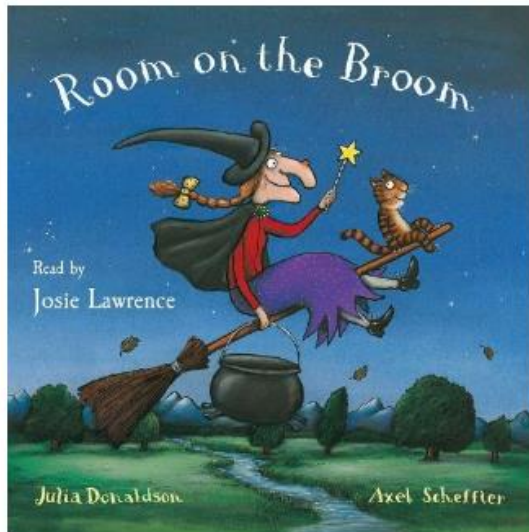


Autumn

- I will learn a new 'word aware' word and apply it in my play.



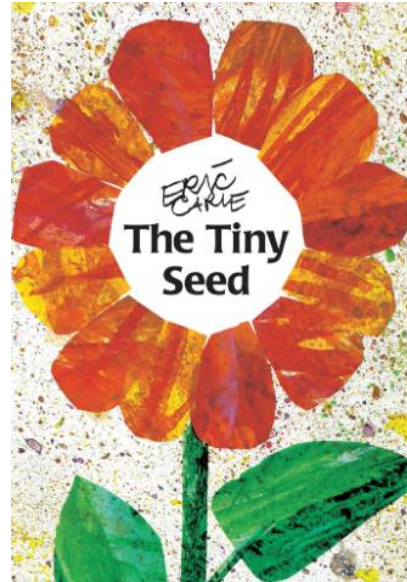
Maths

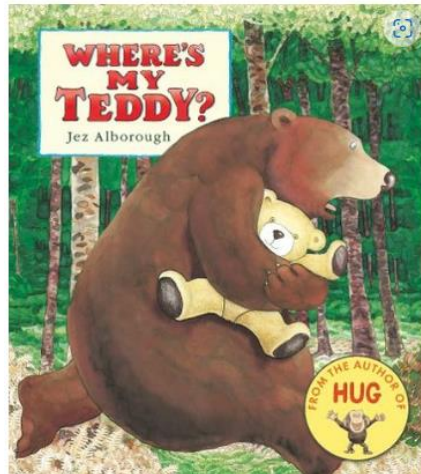
Expressive Arts and Design
