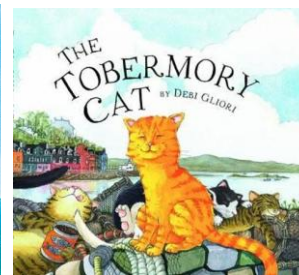
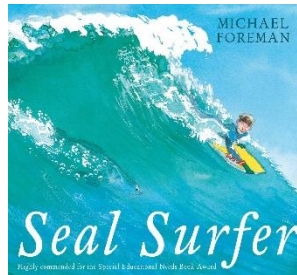

British Isles	Consists of the islands of Great Britain, Ireland, the Isle of Man, the Inner and Outer Hebrides, the Northern Isles and over six thousand smaller islands.
Great Britain	The island made up of England, Scotland and Wales.
United Kingdom	Consists of 4 countries: England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland.
Human features	Are man-made features like churches, bridges and castles.
Physical features	Natural features such as hills, mountains and rivers.
