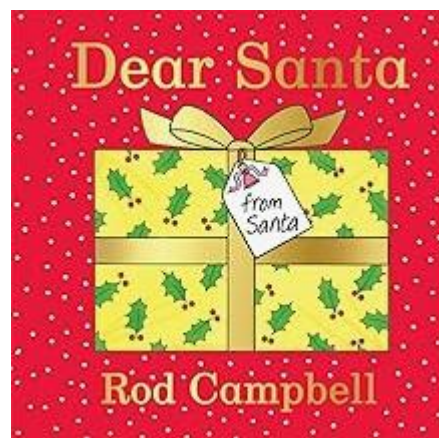


Autumn

- I will follow simple class rules.

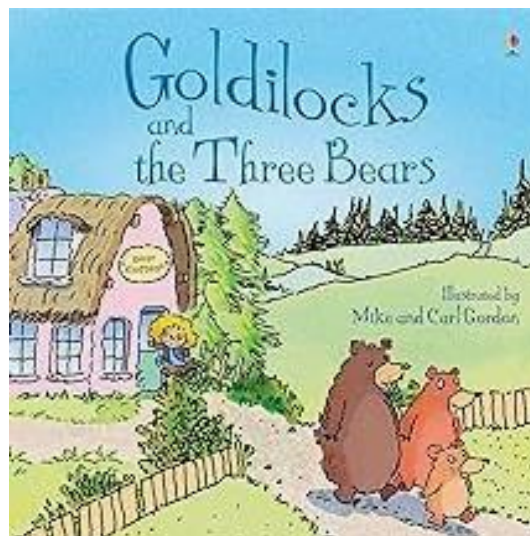


Literacy

- I will sequence events.



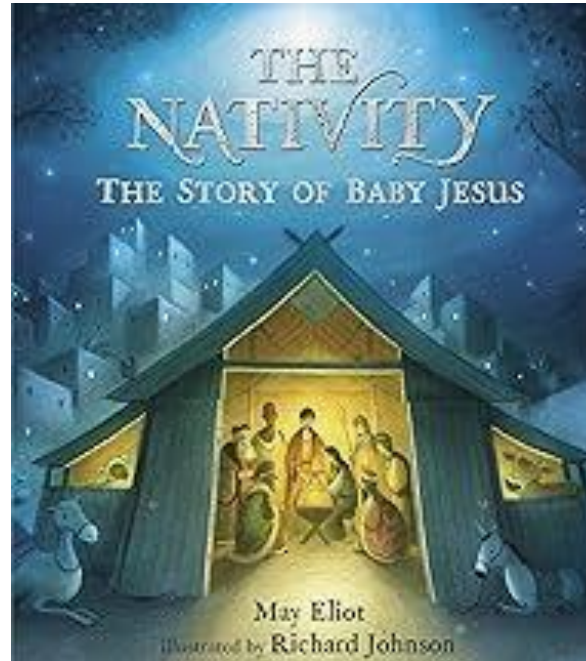
Communication and Language and Understanding the World

Expressive Arts and Design

- I will learn about Jackson Pollock and will talk about his work.
