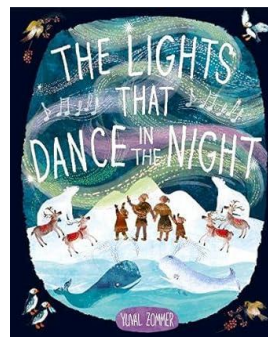
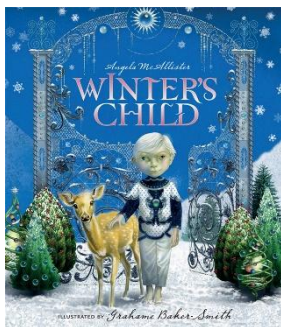
As Writers we will
