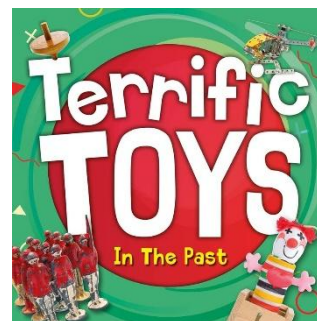
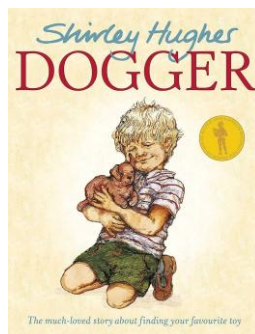
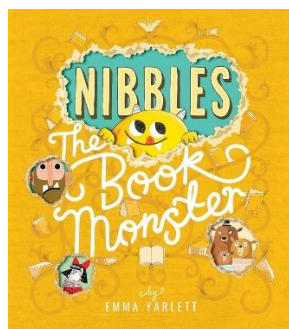
As Writers we will
