

As Mathematicians we will

Be continuing our learning about multiplication and division, where we will practise our times tables and make connections between different times tables. Then, we will move onto learning about area.

In Religious Education we will

Be exploring Christianity, focussing on the question, 'How did/does Jesus change lives?'. Through this, we will look at the impact Jesus has on Christians' lives.

As Scientists we will

Be deepening our understanding of rocks. We will be looking at different types of rocks and how we can classify them based on their different properties and purposes. Then, we will be moving onto fossilisation and what we can learn from studying fossils.

As Historians we will

Be heading back to the Stone Age. We will be exploring the lives of hunter-gatherers and focussing on their diets. We will be looking at key Stone Age monuments that still stand today and their significance in the Stone Age. After this, we will be considering their technologies, inventions and how life was similar or different to today. Finally, we will be looking at the importance of Skara Brae and what it looks like today. We will then be experts on the Stone Age.

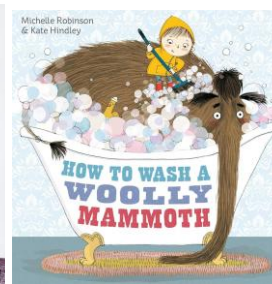
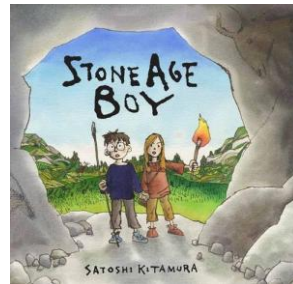
As Writers we will

Be exploring historical narratives through our class text 'Stone Age Boy'. Through this unit, we will write our own Stone Age adventure using past and present tense correctly. Year 3 will focus on using inverted commas for speech and grouping related ideas into paragraphs, whilst Year 4 will focus on using and punctuating direct speech, organising paragraphs around a theme and using fronted adverbials.

In Computing we will

Be continuing to develop our understanding of coding using PurpleMash. We will plan algorithms and write code that includes angles of turn to create routes for screen turtles, testing them using 2Go.

As Sports People we will
