

As Mathematicians we will

Begin by looking at addition and subtraction. We will be adding and subtracting 1's and 10's before we look at 2 digit numbers. We will then move on to multiplication and division.

As Writers we will

Be reading the book 'The Lion Inside' by Jim Field. Year 1's will practise using 'and' to join words and clauses and begin to use the prefix 'un' and the suffixes '-ed, -ing and -er. Year 2 will be using subordination (because, when), using tenses correctly and using exclamation and question marks.

In Computing we will

Begin by looking at online safety and the importance of passwords. We will then explore Purple Mash with a focus on ways of grouping and sorting and pictograms.

In Religious Education we will

Be exploring why the church is such an important place for Christians and why holy buildings are important to people of different faiths.

As Scientists we will


Be considering what materials different objects are made from. We will be specifically looking at the properties of glass, wood, metal, water and rock. Then, we will begin to group together materials based on their properties and compare them. Finally, we will carry out simple tests to find out the best material for a given object.

As Geographers we will

Be heading to South Africa. We will be using a range of maps to find out where South Africa is and using directional language to suggest how we would get there. Then, we will be identifying the city of Cape town. We will be exploring both the human and physical features of Cape Town. Next, we will be looking at the weather in Cape Town at different times of the year and comparing it to Nantwich. We will be considering whether there are any similarities. Finally, we will be 'talking like an expert' on why someone should visit Cape Town.
