


# Spring 2

## Personal, Social, Emotional Development



- I will know that when I am angry or upset, I can go into the dark den and have a cuddle and listen to a story to calm me down.

### Expressive Arts and Design

- I will make images of ducks using paint and my hands and fingers.

### Physical Development

- I will fit myself into tunnels and move to the end to get out. I can go into spaces under and through equipment.
- I will maintain a correct grip on scissors when positioned by an adult.
- I will begin to make snips on paper.
- I will string large beads and reels.
- I will use a spoon correctly to feed myself and fill containers.
- I will screw lids on and off.

### Understanding the World

- I will talk about where ducks live and what they eat.
- I will pretend to clean and tidy in the home role play area, using new vocabulary and with others.
- I will talk about the differences in character from familiar stories.
- I will talk about how the ground feels when I walk in bare foot.
