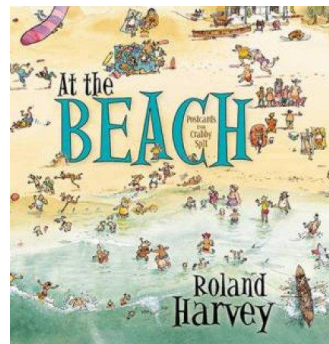
**As Writers we will**
