

As Mathematicians we will

Be completing our learning about length and perimeter before moving onto fractions. In our fractions unit, we will be learning about what fractions are, comparing and ordering fractions, comparing and ordering mixed numbers and converting between improper fractions and mixed numbers.

In Religious Education we will

Be looking at forgiveness in different world faiths before moving onto learning all about the church and exploring the question, 'Are all churches the same?'

As Scientists we will

Be looking at the importance of forces and magnets. We will be considering which objects are magnetic and their properties. Then, we will be exploring the strength of different magnets and we will be creating a table to represent this data.

As Historians we will

Be heading back in time to Ancient Egypt. We will be considering how archaeologists use artefacts to deepen their knowledge of this period of time and what remains of it today. We will be exploring the lives of everyday people in Ancient Egypt as well as the role of pharaohs. Then, we will be looking at the importance of the River Nile for both transport and trade. Finally, we will be looking at Ancient Egyptian Gods and comparing them to Greek gods.

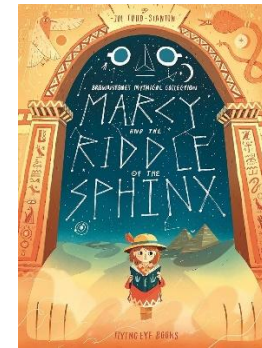
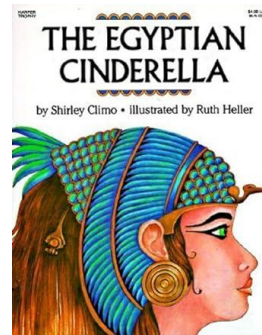
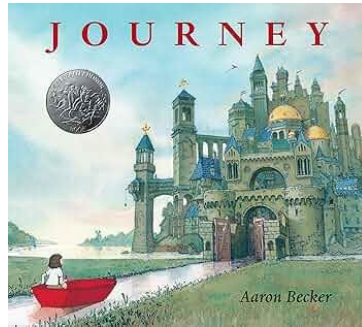
As Writers we will

In Computing we will
