Homework activities for this term are outlined below.

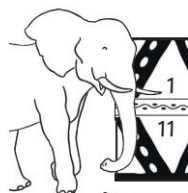
You will receive 'Dojo Points' for each task completed and at the end of term, your homework will be displayed in the hall for everyone to see.
