<p><b>Understanding the World:</b> Try growing some plants or flowers at home. You could try planting some seeds in a pot or in your garden. Remember to give your seeds some water and put them somewhere sunny.</p> 	<p><b>Maths:</b> Have a look around your home and find 2 things that you think will float and 2 things that you think will sink. Ask a grown-up to help you test if you are right..</p> 	<p><b>Understanding the World:</b> Can you research a jungle animal? You could use a book or the Internet. Draw a picture or write some facts down to share with the class!</p> 
<p><b>Expressive Art and Design:</b> Can you make a model of a jungle animal? You could use modelling dough, a paper plate or bowl, cardboard boxes and tubes. Try making a lion, snake or elephant!</p> 	<p><b>English:</b> Pretend a monkey is sending a message and write/ draw what he is saying eg “Come play in the trees”</p> 	<p><b>Expressive Art and Design:</b> Can you try 3-5 different fruits and talk about the flavour? Is it sweet or sour? Soft or crunchy? Which do you like the best? Take some photos to share.</p>
