FLU VACCINATION 2025

THE CONSENT LINK HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO SUNDAY 28th SEPTEMBER @ MIDNIGHT. The Flu vaccination team will be school on Wednesday 1st October for Reception to Year 6. N.B. The vaccination in most cases is given by a simple spray up the nose, for those parents/guardians who object to the nasal vaccine on the grounds of porcine gelatine content or dietary requirements, an alternative vaccination (injection) is also available.

Unfortunately, Nursery children will need to see their GP for their vaccination.


