TOUCAN CROSSINGS

Now I am sure we can all agree the 4-way traffic lights on Broadstone Road are frustrating – but did you know they are actually installing toucan crossings which will improve road safety for our children travelling to & from school by foot or bikes? They do say however, the works will take approximately 5 months to complete.

<u>Keswick Road / Briarfield Road:</u> A Toucan crossing will be provided on Broadstone Road between the junctions with Keswick Road & Briarfield Road including adequate widening of the footways for pedestrian/cyclist use; narrowing the mouth of the side road junctions & therefore reducing vehicle entry speeds to these roads & overall improving safety.

Nelstrop Road / Downham Road: A Toucan crossing will also be provided on Broadstone Road between the junctions with Nelstrop Road and Downham Road.
