NUT FREE SCHOOL

We have children in school who suffer from SEVERE nut allergies in school. We implore you to empathise and ensure that this must NEVER happen.

The following items SHOULD NOT be brought into school:

- **NO** packets of nuts
- **NO** Whitworths mixed nuts sachets
- **NO** peanut butter sandwiches
- **NO Nutella** (Chocolate Spread)
- **NO** pesto on pasta/wraps (made with pine nuts)
- **NO** fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts
- **NO** chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts (Celebrations i.e. Snickers)
- **NO** sesame seed rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame)
- **NO** cakes made with nuts
