Ellis, my dog was back in school today, to pick up where we left off from his previous visit.


The weather scuppered us last time as it was too icy to go out but today all the children had the opportunity to walk Ellis on his lead around the local area during their "Weekly Wander."

All will be revealed by class teachers but we will be grateful for parental support in encouraging children to read, develop a love of books and engage in book talk with adults and peers.

With the children's help, he found out the penguin had come from the South Pole and he asked for the children's help to build a boat to get him there. They explored and described different materials, deciding the boat must float and be waterproof so it wouldn't sink. This led to testing different materials in our water trays and the children used some amazing language to describe how the materials felt and what happened. They even took their boats outside and created a channel. Amazing work!



STOCKPORT COUNTY KS2 ASSEMBLY


Stockport County PLUS the ever-popular Vernon Bear mascot were in school today delivering a fun, interactive assembly and the kids **LOVED IT!**
