HEADTEACHERS NOTE

As previously shared, we have recently transitioned our school lunch ordering system from Lunch Hound to a much more integrated platform, called Cypad – easily accessible through your [ParentPay Portal](#).

However, has been brought to my attention that a significant number of meals are **not** being pre-ordered at home. Consequently, teaching staff are spending considerable classroom time managing these orders manually. To ensure that learning time is protected and prioritized, staff will no longer be responsible for placing individual meal orders in class. **Effective from Monday 13th April, any child without a pre-ordered lunch will automatically be provided with a jacket potato as a default meal.** Please see attached letter for full details.

Additionally, Taylor Shaw are increasing their meal prices from £2.80 to **£3.00** per meal, due to two significant legislative changes which have directly impacted their costs. **We have insisted on 4 weeks' notice period for our parents; therefore this will be effective from 01/05/2026.**
