Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had another fun and busy week in Reception! Here's a little snapshot of what we've been learning together:

#### **Drawing Club**

In Drawing Club, we based our learning on **Road Runner**. The children drew the main character, the setting, and designed an invention they would make to help **Wile E. Coyote** go faster! We also used our phonics skills to write "code words" to make the magic happen, which was great fun and a fantastic way to apply our phonics learning.

#### **Maths**

In maths, we explored the composition of 5 using the song *5 Little Speckled Frogs*. The children practised using mathematical language such as "5 is made of 3 and 2" and "4 and 1," helping them to understand how numbers can be broken down in different ways.

#### **PE**

In PE, we continued to practise our ball skills, focusing on dribbling and controlling the ball.

#### **RE**

In RE, the children enjoyed sharing their special objects with their classmates and talking about why they are important to them. If your child didn't bring an object in this week, please send it in by next Tuesday and they will have the opportunity to share then.

#### **EAD (Expressive Arts and Design)**

The children used their creativity to design and make traps to catch the Road Runner. There were some fantastic ideas and lots of imaginative thinking!
