Routines and Equipment

PE/Swimming : children should come dressed for PE/Forest School on Monday and PE on Friday. Please ensure your child has the correct PE uniform and earrings must be removed, not taped.

Forest School: outdoor PE Kit- long jogging bottoms, T shirt and jumper (Please follow the uniform policy for PE) Suitable shoes/boots.

We will be out whatever the weather! If it is raining we have waterproofs.

Homework: Homework will be given out on a Friday and handed in the following Friday. Children are expected to finish all homework given and lunchtime will be used to complete homework if this has not been done at home. All homework will be on the weekly blog for ease of reference and we will also use Google Classroom too.

Please support your child.

Reading Giants: Weekly reads will be counted every Friday and will run from Friday to Friday so please make sure these are recorded in the planner (5 reads per week minimum). This can include an adult reading, audio books, comics. It is important that children experience reading for pleasure as well as reading their reading books.

Equipment: Reading book, diary, clear water bottle and coat need to be in school every day. Please do not bring a pencil case into school, as the children are provided with all the resources they will need.

Uniform: Please ensure your child is wearing the correct uniform and school shoes. Uniform plays a key role in promoting a school's ethos, providing a sense of belonging and identity and creating a learning environment. There is also a uniform expectation for PE-please see our website.

Communication: look at the weekly class blog, read the weekly newsletter, look at the information board by the steps, look on the website.

Speaking to Teachers: we have an open-door policy and parents are encouraged to make an appointment if they would like to discuss anything. Should your child share something with you at home, please contact us to gain an accurate understanding of what has happened as often children's perceptions of events can be different.

School Vision: confident, successful and responsible – independence and resilience are important skills for now and life- children are not too young.

Times tables: please, please, please practise these at home as much as possible.
