



Welcome to Hedgehogs Class

In Hedgehogs Class, we encourage and develop independence, a love for learning, resilience, growth mindset and organisational skills to enable the children to be confident, responsible and successful.

Routines and Equipment

PE/Swimming : On **Mondays**, children will need their swimming kits. On **Thursday**, they will have their PE session. Please ensure your child has the correct PE uniform and it is named.

Forest School – On **Monday**, the children will need to come to school in old clothes that they can get dirty, we would like the children to be in tracksuit bottoms or leggings to protect their legs in the woods. As the weather changes in autumn term, we would like the children to bring in wellies or old trainers.

Homework: Homework will be given out each **Friday** and handed in the **following Friday**. Children are expected to finish all homework given and lunchtime will be used to complete homework if this has not been done at home. This includes spelling homework. All homework will be on the weekly blog for ease of reference.

Spellings: There will be a spelling sheet to complete and hand in each week as part of their homework.

Reading Giants: Weekly reads will be counted every **Friday** and will run from Friday to Friday so please make sure these are recorded in their diary (5 reads per week minimum) and you have signed their diary. The children will not receive a sticker unless it is signed!

Equipment: Reading book, diary and a drinks bottle need to be in school every day. Please do not bring a pencil case into school, as the children are provided with all the resources they will need.

Uniform: Please ensure your child is wearing the correct uniform and school shoes with all items named. Uniform plays a key role in promoting a school's ethos, providing a sense of belonging and identity and creating a learning environment.
