Dear parents and carers,

During year 4, your child will take part in the Primary School Swimming Programme. We will be going swimming every Monday at the East Manchester Leisure Centre. The first lesson will take place on Monday 11th September 2023.

Please note:

- Children will be accompanied by school staff and parents are not permitted to watch
- Children must wear appropriate clothing. Please see overleaf for examples
- No jewellery is allowed whilst swimming, e.g. earrings, bracelets and necklaces
- Girls and boys with long hair must wear a swimming hat
- Goggles are only allowed for medical reasons. A letter from a doctor or optician must be provided if your child wears goggles
- Swimming lessons are compulsory - they are a requirement of the National curriculum and are not optional.

Changing Arrangements

Children must get changed in designated same sex changing rooms. The changing rooms are not accessible to the public. For safeguarding reasons, children either change in a large same sex group changing room or a smaller same sex group cubicle.

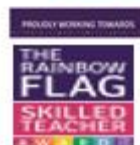
