Make a timeline of key events from your life.	Write a poem about what friendship means to you.	Imagine that you are 50 years old - write a biography telling us what you have become.
Write instructions on how to keep friendships healthy.	Design an outfit you would wear to an event that celebrates individuality. What makes you special and unique?	Interview a family member. Design 8 questions to ask a member of your family - record the answers they give.	Surprise your teacher (with a piece of homework of your own choosing!)
