Geography Vocabulary - Our Local Area:

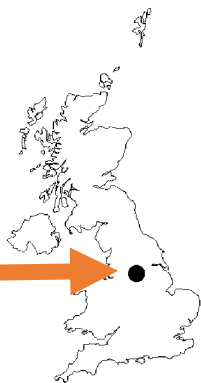
- map** - a picture of a particular area of the earth
aerial view - looking down on the earth from up in the sky
fieldwork - practical investigation in nature
human features - things in nature created by humans, e.g. buildings, bridges
physical features - things in nature which are natural e.g. hills, rivers
coastal - the land next to the sea or ocean
inland - in the part of a country that is away from the coast
woodland - an area of land covered with trees
river - a large, natural stream of flowing freshwater
village - a small town or community, often in the country
town - an area with streets, houses, and buildings that is larger than a



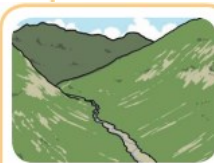
village but usually smaller than a city
city - a large and important town where many people live and work

Science Vocabulary - Animals, Including Humans:

- animal** - a living thing that eats and can move around
habitat - where an animal or plant lives
mammal - an animal with warm blood, which has live babies (not eggs) and the babies drink their mother's milk
bird - an animal with warm blood, which has feathers, a beak, no teeth, wings and lays eggs
fish - an animal with cold blood, which lives in water and breathes through gills, they lay eggs and normally have fins
reptile - an animal with cold blood and a body covered with scales, they lay eggs
amphibian - an animal with cold blood that can live on land and in the water, they have webbed feet and lay eggs
insect - an animal with cold blood and six legs, they have normally wings and lay eggs
zoo - a place which looks after wild animals from around the world
carnivore - an animal that eats other animals
herbivore - an animal that eats plants
omnivore - an animal that eats other animals and
