poor - having very little money and few things

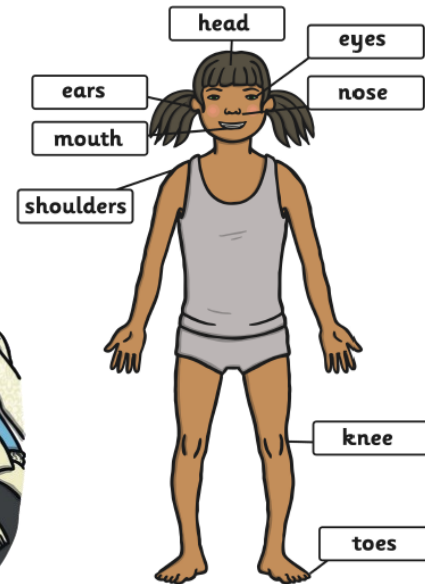
workhouse - a big building where poor people, orphans and the sick lived and worked in Victorian times to earn food and shelter

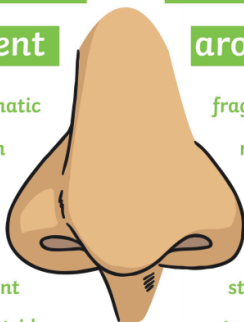

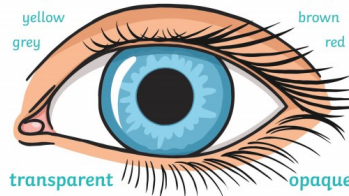
