For this half term's home learning you can choose any of the ideas below to do at home.

Please do at least one and then bring it in to share.

Imagine you were a child and had to work every day in a factory. Write a letter to Queen Victoria to tell her how you feel about it.



Look around your house and list what you can find that is made in Sheffield.

Be careful around any sharp objects - ask a grown up to help.



Was someone in your family 'made in Sheffield'?

Find out details such as where they were born, which school they went to, where they lived as a child etc. If you can, bring in a photo of them then and another of them now.



Steel has to be very, very hot to melt and be made into new shapes in factories.

With a grown up, can you melt some chocolate at home and do something to give it a new shape?
