Design a tourist poster to advertise a country in North or South America.	Choose either major rivers or mountain ranges in North or South America. Create a poster about them.	Research a famous American and write a fact file.
Research Christopher Columbus and plot his original journeys on a world map.	Find out the height of the top 10 tallest buildings or landmarks in North and South America and order them.	Create your own menu for an American diner or Mexican restaurant.	Choose 5 different countries from across the Americas. Draw their flags and explain what the designs represent.
Research some examples of Native American-style art, then make your own version.	Write a non-chronological report about an animal native to North or South America.	Choose a destination in the Americas. Imagine you have been on holiday there and write a diary about your trip.	Surprise your teacher. Create your own task based on the Americas to amaze your teacher!
