The top row of choices will especially help you during your history lessons so try picking at least one homework idea from there.

Create a timeline of Ancient Egypt. Label it with dates of some important pharaohs, inventions, buildings (pyramids and tombs), etc.	Research a primary source from Ancient Egypt. What do you interpret from it? What does it tell you about Ancient Egypt?	Find out about Ancient Egyptian religion. Create top trumps cards using Ancient Egyptian gods and goddesses.
Write an adventure story set in Ancient Egypt.	Design/make an Egyptian mummy or sarcophagus.	Make your own set of canopic jars. What would you keep inside them?
Design a tourist leaflet to persuade visitors to go to Egypt.	Create a fact file about a famous Egyptian. Do you agree with the different secondary sources about them?	Research how mummies were made. Write instructions to make a mummy.
Design/make some model Ancient Egyptian jewellery.	Bake Ancient Egyptian flatbread and write out the recipe.	Write 5 questions you would want to ask someone from Ancient Egyptian society. Write the answers that they give.
